INSTRUCTIONS

Harbison State Forest has seven individual geocaches hidden along the Learning and Discovery Trails located near the Education Center. Each geocache contains information regarding the different divisions and duties within South Carolina Forestry Commission. There is an accompanying set of seven questions (1 for each cache) that can be completed and turned into the Education Center (log cabin building). If you answer all seven questions correctly, you will receive a South Carolina Forestry Commission commemorative coin!

To get started, park in the Education Center parking lot and don't forget to pay the parking fee (\$5.00 daily). Download the GEOCACHING app and follow the below steps.

- 1. Register for a free Basic Membership.
- 2. Go to the home page and locate the search bar.
- 3. Enter the location "Harbison State Forest" and click search.
- 4. Choose any of the caches titled "Harbison State Forest Geocache #". All seven caches can be found near the Education Center, on the Learning and Discovery Trails.
- 5. Select "Navigate" and the app will guide you to the geocache. Or you can enter the coordinates into your GPS device to assist you in finding the hidden geocache.
- 6. Once you find the geocache sign the logbook, answer your question, and return the geocache to its original location. Don't forget to leave an item in the cache if you take one.
- 7. Continue along until you have found all seven geocaches.

The Education Center is open Monday through Friday 8:00am - 4:30pm. Due to limited staffing on the weekends, you may not be able to receive your South Carolina Forestry Commission coin.
